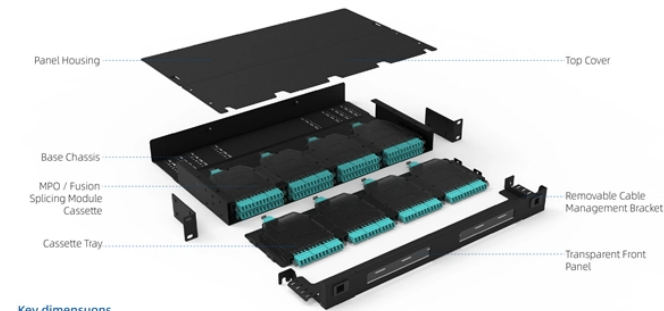
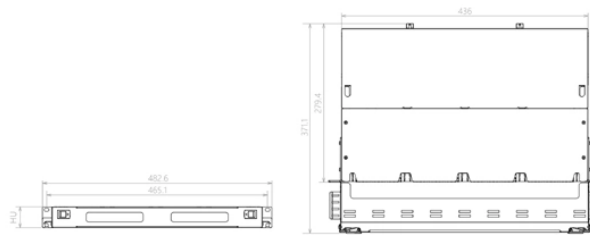

Key dimensions



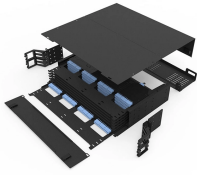

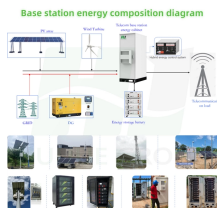
