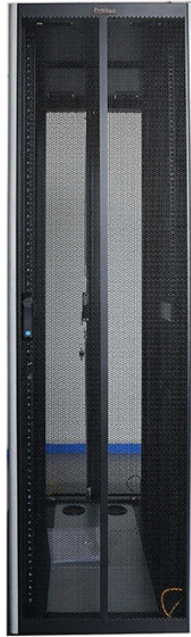


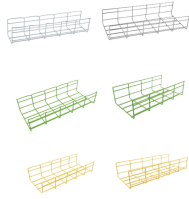
Additional Optical Cable OPAC



Overview

OPAC (optical power attached cable) is a type of fiber optic cable that is installed by attaching to a host conductor along overhead power lines. In their served areas will be power generating stations, alternative energy sources (solar, wind, geotherman, etc.), substations for distribution and microgrids. The attachment system varies and can include wrapping, lashing or clipping the fibre-optical cable. Types of power special optical cable and field optical fiber Power special optical cable generally refers to OPGW (optical composite ground wire), OPPC (optical composite phase wire), MASS (metal self-supporting optical cable), ADSS (all-dielectric self-supporting optical cable), ADL (phase/ground).
