

Are optical cables and optical fibers used in the same way



Overview

Optical fiber consists of a core and a cladding layer, selected for due to the difference in the refractive index between the two. In practical fibers, the cladding is usually coated with a layer of polymer. This coating protects the fiber from damage but does not contribute to its optical properties. Individual coated fibers (or fibers formed into ribbons or bundles) then have various applications.

A fiber-optic cable, also known as an optical-fiber cable, is an assembly similar to an electrical cable but containing one or more optical fibers that are used to carry light.

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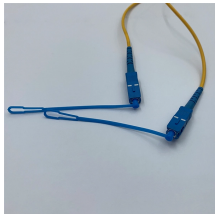
