

Big Round Tail Fiber



Overview

FC connects to the ODF box, and SC connects to the optical port of the device. FC-FC, commonly known as round-to-round pigtail. Generally used as fiber jumpers between ODF racks. FS fiber optic pigtails offer a fast way to make fiber optic communication devices in the field by fiber splicing, fully manufactured and tested by industrial standards. 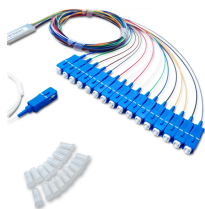

The bundled pigtail has only one end with a connector, and the other end is a broken end of an optical fiber, which is connected to other optical fiber cores by fusion splicing.



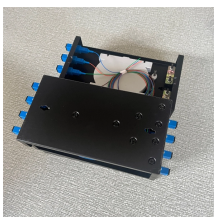
A fiber optic pigtail is a short, usually unjacketed, optical fiber cable that has a factory-installed connector on one end and a length of exposed fiber at the other.



High quality fiber pigtails combined with correct fusion splicing practices offer the best performance for fiber optic cable termination. 99% of single mode applications use pigtails, but pigtails are also used ...
