

## Cable tray is flipped upwards



### Overview

Above is basically a solution by means of standard MEP Modelling. As you can see from the image illustrated below ☐☐ I have a set of cable tray run in my model which I need to change their rotation by 180 degrees. Also, is it possible to place a new cable trays inverted in such a way that the bottom of the cable tray is upside?

I welcome any ideas or suggestions. This includes Conduits and Cable Trays, along with fitting components for these element types. However, Cable Trays do have certain limitations in that the channel shape can only be set to a horizontal aspect where the bottom edge runs parallel to its supports. In my limited experience, the biggest added risk is the greater opportunity for a baboon installer to overtighten a ty-rap, cutting through the cable insulation. Anyone have a solution to rotating horizontal tray so it can be ran vertically?

We've been asking for 13 years now, still no way to do it (that I'm aware of). Any suggestions?
