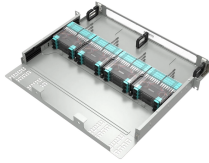


## Overview

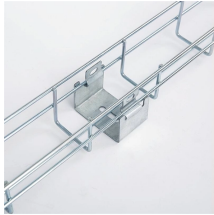
