

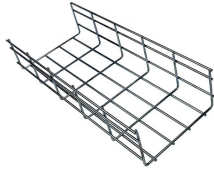
Disable MAC address access on the switch



Overview

Navigate to Settings > WiFi > Advanced. Choose whether to build a Deny or Allow List. Fill the list with the MAC Address of the device (s) you wish to include. This number is the total of available MAC addresses, including those used for other Layer 2 functions and any other secure MAC addresses. Add or delete devices from the list of authorized addresses for one or more ports. Specifies a list of one or more ports to which the port-security command applies. On. ☐ Critical for Network Security: Without proper switch port security, a single rogue device can flood your CAM table with fake MAC addresses, forcing your switch into hub mode and exposing all network traffic. Navigate to. MAC (Multimedia Access Control) addresses are unique sets of codes assigned to electronic devices that identify the devices on a network. This can be a security risk when users connect.

Port security is a security feature of Cisco switches that allows you to control what source MAC addresses are allowed to enter a switchport.

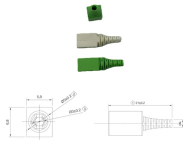
MAC filters work by either allowing or denying only specific MAC addresses. MAC filters are a great security measure; however, if your network needs to be open to public or guests, or ...

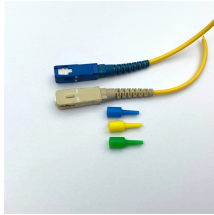

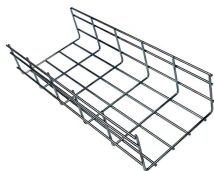
When a port disconnects from the switch, the system immediately removes the dynamic secure MAC addresses, even if the port-security aging inactivity is configured to retain those addresses.
