

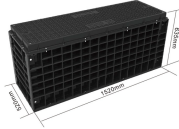
Does the SFP optical module need to be configured

SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) is a compact, hot-pluggable network interface module used to connect network devices (switches, routers, firewalls) to fiber optic or copper cables. Think of it as the “translator” for your network equipment, converting electrical signals into optical signals. The QSFP-DD, QSFP, and SFP transceiver modules are hot-swappable and connect the electrical circuitry of the system with an optical external network. They enable high-speed connections between active equipment and allow system scalability without the need for full infrastructure replacement.
