

Does the cable tray need to be fitted with fireproof boards



Overview

Install fire barriers within the tray to isolate different fire zones. When cable trays pass through walls or floors, seal openings using fire-rated penetration sealing materials. Process flow: reserved openings → busway installation → distribution box positioning and installation →. The primary rulebook used in the safe use of cable trays is NEC Article 392. This is a description of how to select, install, and support these metal or plastic frames, on which electrical wires are installed. These systems prevent fire and smoke from spreading through open cable pathways, maintaining circuit integrity and code. Understanding proper cable tray fire safety practices is essential for protecting buildings, equipment, and occupants.
