

Does the switch have two fiber optic cables connected



Overview

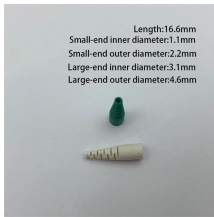
A fiber optic switch is an electronic device that allows multiple fiber optic cables to be connected and selectively route data between them. It can provide significantly higher bandwidth and carry more data. A Fiber Optic Network is connected to the SC Duplex COMMON port allowing access to two other Fiber Optic Networks connected to the SC Duplex A and B ports. The DB9 remote allows control and monitoring of the switch using ASCII RS232 commands. Can two switches with optical ports be directly connected by optical fiber?

Yes, the main line of the optical fiber LAN is a direct. The switch has two console ports: a USB 5-pin mini-Type B port on the front panel (see Figure 54 on page 85) and an RJ-45 console port on the rear panel. The USB Type A-to-USB mini-Type B cable is not.

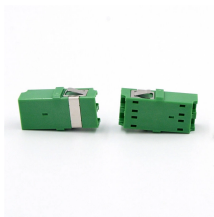

In cases where the distance between switches exceeds the total cable length, you can use the LC-LC coupler to connect two fiber optic cables together. For example, insert the connector ...

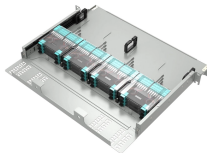
You need to provide an RJ-45-to-DB-25 female DTE adapter if you want to connect the switch console port to a terminal. You can order a kit (part number ACS-DSBUASYN=) containing that adapter.
