

Factory cable tray positioning



Overview

All tray items whether stored outside or indoors, should be placed on sufficient support, to enable future mechanical lifting. When completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is erect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. Cable tray (or cable ladder) systems are a popular alternative to electrical conduit systems, as they have an outstanding record for dependable service, design flexibility and cost savings in commercial and industrial applications. 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Cable tray length is selected based on the load to be supported, the distance between the supports (also referred to as the span), and handling and installation constraints.

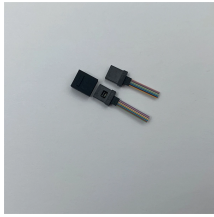
