To test a solar panel using a multimeter, ensure the panel is exposed to sunlight, set the multimeter to the appropriate voltage range, and connect the multimeter leads to the solar panel's positive and negative terminals. Measure Voc (open circuit voltage) — if it reads 0V, the panel or wiring is dead. If Voc is normal but the system is not producing, the problem is downstream. 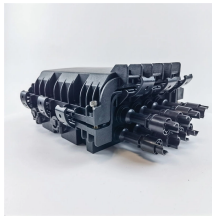

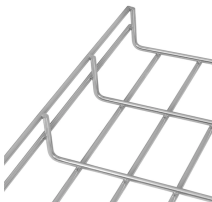
