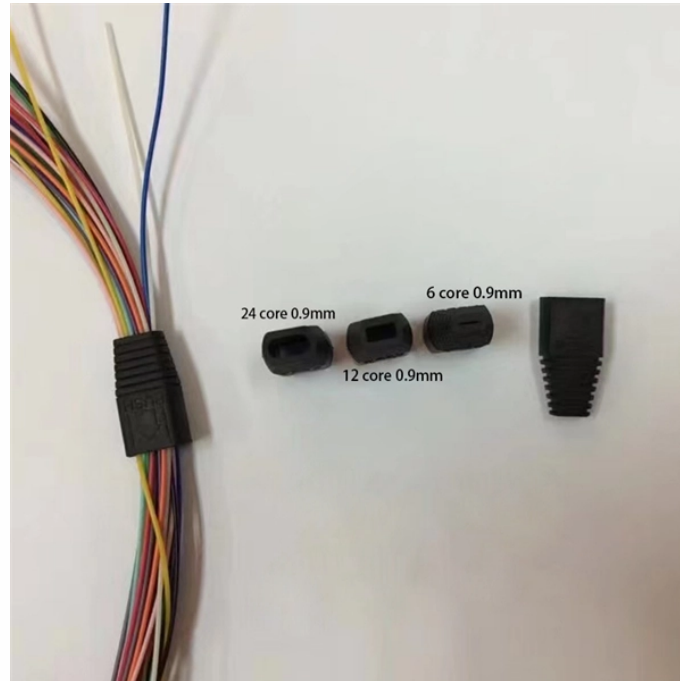


Hungarian Bridge Frame Family Discipline Ruler

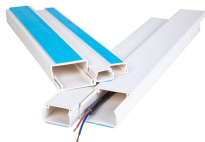
