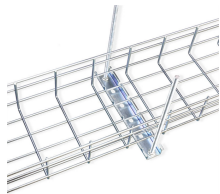
if you are going to connect fiber to the switch, you do it with transceivers. Some switches have fiber transceiver ports built in and some require an add-on module to insert fiber transceivers.

You need to provide an RJ-45-to-DB-25 female DTE adapter if you want to connect the switch console port to a terminal. You can order a kit (part number ACS-DSBUASYN=) containing that adapter.



Insert the end of your fiber optic network line into the fiber optic connector on the converter box. Plug an Ethernet cable into the Ethernet port on the converter box and plug the other...



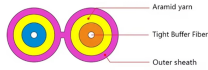
Choose an SFP module based on the fiber optic cabling that will be connected to the network switches. SFP transceiver modules almost always require two fiber optic cable strands.
