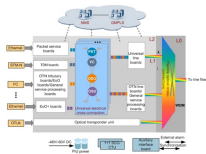

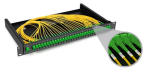

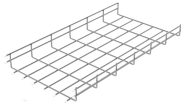

Fiber strippers are precision tools that reliably and cleanly remove a defined length of coating (often 30-40 mm) from a fiber end so that the bare glass is exposed without scratching or nicking it.
