

Taiwan Dedicated Fiber Cable Fault



Overview

TAIPEI (Taiwan News) — Chunghwa Telecom reported Monday that an undersea cable connecting Taiwan and the outlying Matsu Islands has been disconnected due to an abnormality. To date, Taiwan's limited response to China's cable cutting (see discussion below) has not conveyed a desire to deter further action. Taipei should increase its response capabilities to monitor and intercept ships loitering near cables, develop domestic cable repair capabilities, and invest in. 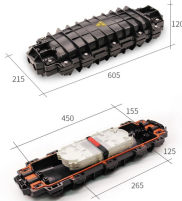

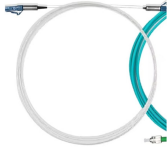

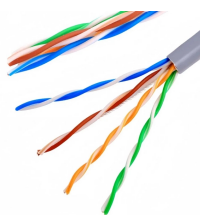
