Four wires are involved in supplying the main panel with power. Three of them will come from the utility pole, and a fourth (bare) wire. The bare wire is connected to one or more long metal bars driven into the ground, or to a wire buried in the foundation, or sometimes to the water supply pipe. There are several excellent choices, depending on the application's needs. XLPE (cross-linked polyethylene) has excellent dielectric properties and offers a high level of thermal resistance. 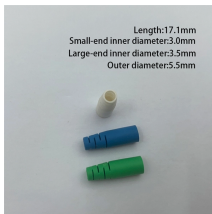
