

What to do if the terminal box can't connect to the internet



Overview

For Wi-Fi, head to your POS system's settings, find your network, and type in the password. Going wired?

Grab an Ethernet cable, plug one end into the router and the other into your POS device. Most systems will recognize the connection automatically. Are you experiencing issues with your internet connection, and you suspect that your Optical Network Terminal (ONT) box might be the culprit?

Resetting your ONT box can often resolve connectivity problems, but it's essential to do it correctly to avoid any unintended consequences. If you see NO IP Address or it is stuck on "getting IP info. ": Lift the base of the terminal and locate the USB-C Cable plugged. If your terminal has an Ethernet port, connecting the terminal to your internet router using an Ethernet cable is the recommended option. We'll take a look at some manufacturers such as Ingenico, Dejavoo, & Pax devices.

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Unscrew the silver locking screw, then unplug the cable from the base of the terminal. When plugging it back in, make sure it clicks into place before tightening the locking screw.



If your fiber terminal was installed in your garage or outside your home, it's likely that it plugs into a ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) outlet. These have built-in circuit breakers that can trip when ...
