Safety and signal integrity can be maintained by following the separation guidelines for the most common telecommunication pathway designs. In order to do this, they use some very different types of cables. ADSS cables are designed to withstand very high-tension loads.

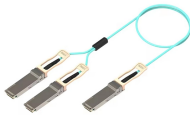
